1. QUALIFICATION

(1) Applicants must have Thai nationality.

(2) Applicants must have attained a <u>cumulative GPA of at least 3.00</u> on a 4.00 GPA scale at an upper secondary school.

2. APPLICATION AND SELECTION PROCEDURES IN THAILAND

The Embassy of Japan in Thailand will conduct the First Screening of applicants by means of screening the submitted application documents, written examinations and interviews. The decision on successful candidates made by the Embassy of Japan is final and the reasons will not be disclosed. Any queries on the final decision will not be entertained.

Please understand that submitted application documents will be screened. Applicants may be selected to take the written examination in limited numbers, and MEXT scholarship selection for 2023 in Thailand may be cancelled in case a written examination cannot be conducted due to the COVID-19 situation.

- 2. The Embassy of Japan does not request to submit Recommendation Letter and Medical Certificate at the time of application. They will be requested when applicants have passed the First Screening. Please submit the application documents following the above list.
- 3. Your application may be rejected if the above application is incomplete, or if some documents are missing.
- 4. The submitted documents will not be returned.
- 5. The set of application documents <u>must be sent only by post</u> to any one of following address. Hand or Messenger Delivered documents will not be accepted.
