JAPANESE GOVERNMENT (MEXT) SCHOLARSHIP FOR 2027 (THAILAND)

— SPECIALIZED TRAINING COLLEGE STUDENTS —

Additional to the Application Guidelines, the details of the selection and some special requirements are set by the Embassy of Japan in Thailand as following. **Please read carefully before submitting the application.**

1. QUALIFICATION

- (1) Applicants must have Thai nationality and have been born on or after April 2, 2002.
- (2) Applicants must have attained a **cumulative GPA of at least 3.00** on a 4.00 GPA scale at an upper secondary school.

2. APPLICATION AND SELECTION PROCEDURES IN THAILAND

The Embassy of Japan in Thailand will conduct the First Screening of applicants by means of screening the submitted application documents, written examination and interview. **The decision on successful candidates made by the Embassy of Japan is final and the reasons will not be disclosed. Any queries on the final decision will not be entertained.**

IMPORTANT NOTES:

1. These documents **must be written in English or Japanese**, or if they are written in any other languages, a translation in either English or Japanese should be attached.
2. Please submit the above list of application documents even though this list is different from the list written in the application guidelines. The Embassy of Japan does **not request to submit Recommendation Letter and Medical Certificate at the time of application.** Applicants will be requested to submit after have passed the first screening.
3. Applicants must paste photographs to the Application Form and Admission Form. However, the

photograph data can also be pasted and printed out.

4. Your application may be rejected if the above application is incomplete, or if some documents are missing.
5. The submitted **documents will not be returned**.
6. Applicants must select by circle one of the examination venues (Bangkok, Chiang Mai, Khon Kaen, Songkhla) **on the Admission Form**.
7. The application documents must be sent **by post** to the Bureau of International Cooperation Office of the Permanent Secretary, Ministry of Education as following address **by Wednesday, 2 June 2026**. Hand or messenger delivered documents will not be accepted.

(5) INTERVIEW EXAMINATION

The applicants who pass the written examination will take an interview examination on Monday, 20 July 2026 at Embassy of Japan in Thailand. The interview will be given in English and/or in Japanese for those who have knowledge of Japanese language.

The Embassy of Japan in Thailand will recommend candidates to MEXT. Then, MEXT will make the final selection. Therefore, those who are recommended will not necessarily be selected as the MEXT Scholarship grantees.
