Subject: Declaration of Intent on the No Gift Policy

(Non-Acceptance of Gifts and Gratuities of Any Kind in Connection with the Performance of Duties)
for Fiscal Year 2026

I, Mrs. Kusuma Nawaphanpimol, Expert in International Cooperation Development, Acting Director of the Bureau of International Cooperation, Office of the Permanent Secretary, Ministry of Education, hereby declare the No Gift Policy for the information of, and compliance by, all executives, ordinary civil servants, general government employees, and officials of the Public Sector Development Group, Office of the Permanent Secretary, Ministry of Education.

Under this policy, all such personnel shall refrain from accepting gifts or gratuities of any kind in connection with the performance of official duties, whether before, during, or after the performance of such duties.

Together, we shall foster a culture of integrity within the organisation, promote moral and ethical awareness, and cultivate positive attitudes and values.

We shall perform our official duties with honesty, integrity, fairness, and transparency, in a manner that is open to scrutiny and free from discrimination. We shall place the public interest above personal interests, demonstrate public-mindedness and responsibility, remain steadfast in doing what is right, and refrain from any conduct that may give rise to a conflict between personal and public interests.

We shall not accept any property or other benefit of monetary value from any person, except for property or benefits to which we are legally entitled under laws, rules, or regulations issued pursuant to statutory provisions.

We shall perform our official duties in strict compliance with applicable laws, rules, regulations, and Cabinet resolutions. We shall also conduct ourselves in strict accordance with the Ethical Standards and the Code of Ethics for Civil Servants.
